<b>Fact Sheets</b>	LawHelpMN.org; search by topic or click “Fact Sheets” on the bottom of the page	Fact sheets are great to hand out to clients or to read to learn basic info about an area of the law. Available in Spanish, Hmong, Somali and other languages. We have booklets available online and in print, too.
<b>LOON &amp; the Staff Directory</b>	LawHelpMN.org; click “LOON” on the bottom of the page (sign-in required)	The Legal Organizations Online Network (LOON) lists legal aid, court self-help centers, law libraries, clinics, & low-cost and sliding-scale services to refer clients for help. Access the Staff Directory via LOON to connect with your colleagues in other legal aid offices.
<b>Advocate Trainings</b>	MNLegalServices.org; then click “Trainings”	Sign up for a webinar, in-person or on-demand training to get those CLE credits. Hone your public speaking skills by participating as a trainer!
<b>MN Legal Advice Online</b>	MNLegalAdvice.org	Pro bono attorneys answer civil legal questions over the internet for clients at or below 200% FPG. A place to refer clients legal aid can’t serve, or clients legal aid is serving who have other problems.
<b>Legal Kiosks</b>	LegalKiosk.org; then click “Locations”	Legal Kiosks are computers located across the state. If you are helping someone who doesn’t have access to technology, they can use a free legal kiosk to apply for legal aid, find legal resources, and, in some cases, attend online meetings and court in privacy.
<b>Online Intake</b>	Online applications are available via LawHelpMN.org, organization’s websites, and legal kiosks	Online intake creates another way for clients to access legal aid & helps coordinate referrals statewide.
<b>ProJusticeMN</b>	ProJusticeMN.org	Visit the library to view practice aids, case law, training materials, and other resources. See a calendar of statewide events and CLEs. Post a case of pro bono representation. Refer your lawyer friends to take a case and learn about volunteering.
